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1. Your International Wedding Weekend at Allegra – Overview

Imagine bringing your families and closest friends together in one place for an entire long weekend – welcome night, wedding day and recovery brunch – without having to worry about hotels, transfers, or what to do between events.

At Jardín Allegra 55, our wedding venue, plus Allegra Homes & Allegra Suites, you're not just booking a venue. You are hosting your loved ones in one private enclave: our wedding venue (Jardín Allegra 55) plus five weekend villas (Allegra Homes) and nine hotel-style rooms inside the garden (Allegra Suites) – all within about a one-minute drive – for a 3-day destination wedding weekend.

Your guests are not scattered across different hotels. They wake up, walk through lush gardens, share breakfast by the pool, celebrate at the same wedding venue, walk back to their villa, and do it all again the next day.

2. Why This Makes Financial Sense vs. US & Caribbean Weddings

Most couples considering a destination wedding compare three options:

- A big-city wedding in New York, Los Angeles, Miami or St. Louis.
- A Caribbean all-inclusive resort (Cancún, Jamaica, Dominican Republic...).
- A smaller, more intimate experience like ours in Mexico.

Typical on-site costs per guest (wedding + hotel for 3 nights, excluding flights) often look like this:

- New York City: around USD \$1,300–1,400+ per guest.
- Los Angeles / Miami: around USD \$1,100–1,200+ per guest.
- St. Louis: around USD \$850–900 per guest.
- Caribbean all-inclusive resorts: around USD \$900–1,200+ per guest.

With us, your fully hosted 3-day private weekend – homes, suites, our wedding venue, Taco Party & Karaoke Night at PRIVE, 10-hour wedding day, recovery brunch and optional hosted transfers – usually lands around USD \$295–395 per guest, depending on the package.

Most guests then spend only about USD \$50–90 extra on additional meals over the whole 3-day stay.

The result: you offer your families an intimate three-day celebration in Mexico, for less than half of what a similar experience usually costs in big US cities or Caribbean resorts.

One of Our Most Iconic Weekends

One of our most iconic weddings was for a beautiful Mexican bride who moved to Iceland, fell in love with a Viking... and then brought an entire group of Icelanders to Mexico for the wedding.

For our team it was both exciting and a little intimidating: my serving team – most of them barely 5'4" tall – suddenly found themselves taking care of brutally tall guests speaking a language they had never heard before, and at first nobody was quite sure how to communicate.

But once the night started – full Mexican spirits, great music and the kind of warm, joyful vibe you only get here – all the barriers disappeared. By midnight, everyone knew that “Hvar er salernið?” meant “Where is the bathroom?”, and by the end of the weekend they were all laughing, dancing and hugging goodbye like old friends.

That’s the kind of cultural mix we love: different worlds meeting in one place, for one unforgettable weekend.

5. Your 3-Day Wedding Weekend Structure

No Formal Rehearsal Dinner – A More Fun Mexican-Style Welcome

Instead of a formal rehearsal dinner, we do something more relaxed and much more fun:

- Taco Party at Pedregal 20, one of our private villas – a casual Mexican-style welcome where everyone can arrive, eat, laugh and start meeting each other.
- Then we walk about 30 seconds to PRIVE at Villa Las Fuentes for a Karaoke & Disco Night – our private club-style space used as your welcome celebration and icebreaker.

It feels less formal, more authentic, and gives your guests a real taste of Mexico from the very first night.

Friday – Taco Party & Karaoke Night at PRIVE

- Taco Party at Pedregal 20.
- Short walk to PRIVE at Villa Las Fuentes for karaoke, disco and dancing.
- Bar service by consumption (or with open bar, depending on package).

Saturday – 10-Hour Wedding Day at Jardín Allegra 55

- Ceremony and reception at Jardín Allegra 55 for 10 hours.
- Full catering and service staff according to your chosen menu.
- DJ & sound for the main event.
- 2 rounds of our signature shot cart included in every weekend package.

Sunday – Recovery Brunch

- Relaxed Recovery Brunch at Jardín Allegra.
- You can choose from three different brunch formats (see below).

6. Our 3-Day Weekend Packages (per guest, in USD)

All packages are priced per adult for a 3-night / 3-day stay. Children’s pricing can be adapted depending on age and sleeping arrangements.

1. Essential Weekend – “Wedding Venue & Homes Takeover” – USD \$295 per guest

A complete 3-day wedding weekend using our wedding venue and homes, ideal for couples who want a beautiful, intimate experience and keep bar options flexible.

Includes:

- 3 nights of accommodation across Allegra Homes & Allegra Suites (subject to final headcount and rooming).
- Welcome Taco Party & Karaoke Night at PRIVE on Friday – starting with a Taco Party at Pedregal 20 and then walking to

PRIVE at Villa Las Fuentes for karaoke, music and dancing as an icebreaker.

- Wedding Day on Saturday – 10 hours of event time at our wedding venue at Jardín Allegra 55:

- Ceremony & reception setup at the venue.
- Full catering and service staff (based on your chosen menu).
- DJ and sound for the main event.

- Recovery Brunch on Sunday at our wedding venue or outdoor areas.

- 2 rounds of our signature shot cart during the wedding (our treat – it's a crowd favorite).

- Basic coordination and on-site hosting throughout the weekend.

- Bar service in PRIVE and during the wedding available by consumption, just like a regular bar (beer, wine and cocktails charged individually).

Investment examples (Essential Weekend):

- 50 guests → USD \$14,750
- 75 guests → USD \$22,125
- 100 guests → USD \$29,500

2. Signature Weekend – “Hosted Transfers” – USD \$345 per guest

Everything in the Essential Weekend, plus hosted transportation so your guests don't have to worry about logistics in Mexico.

Includes:

- All Essential Weekend inclusions, plus:
 - Two private vans (15–20 passengers each) with driver for 3 full days:
 - Airport ↔ Allegra transfers (arrival and departure).
 - Local transfers between homes, suites and our wedding venue as needed.

Investment examples (Signature Weekend):

- 50 guests → USD \$17,250
- 75 guests → USD \$25,875
- 100 guests → USD \$34,500

3. Grand Weekend – “All-In Experience” – USD \$395 per guest

Our most complete 3-day option: everything in Signature, plus a premium open bar night in PRIVE to turn your welcome party into a full Mexican cocktail experience.

Includes:

- All Signature Weekend inclusions, plus:
 - Premium open bar on Friday night in PRIVE (4–5 hours):
 - Whisky (e.g. Johnnie Walker Black Label or similar).
 - Premium tequila.
 - Rum, mixers and soft drinks.
 - Two Mexican beers + two American beers.

It's the closest thing to having your own private club for the night – with your families and friends only, plus disco & karaoke to break the ice and get everyone on the dance floor from day one.

Investment examples (Grand Weekend):

- 50 guests → USD \$19,750
- 75 guests → USD \$29,625
- 100 guests → USD \$39,500

What About Extra Meals?

Outside of the events we host for you (Friday Taco Party & Karaoke Night at PRIVE, Saturday wedding and Sunday brunch), your guests can expect to spend roughly:

- USD \$8–12 for a simple breakfast.
- USD \$10–15 for lunch in a casual restaurant.
- USD \$18–25 for a relaxed dinner out.

Over three days, most guests end up spending around USD \$50–90 total on additional meals and snacks – far less than at most resort destinations.

7. Sunday Recovery Brunch Options (per guest, in USD)

You can choose how you'd like your Sunday to feel: relaxed and casual, or like a second mini-celebration. All brunch options include full service staff, set-up and clean-up, basic décor for the food stations and private use of the garden brunch area.

Taco Brunch – Street-Style Taquiza

A casual, fun and very Mexican way to say goodbye to your guests.

- Mixed taco bar with pastor, bistec, costilla and longaniza.
- Warm tortillas, grilled onions, lime, salsas and traditional garnishes.
- Soft drinks and coffee.
- 4 hours of service.

Approx. price: from USD \$30 per guest – minimum 50 guests.

Barbacoa & Hand-Made Quesadilla Brunch

Perfect for a true “recovery” morning after the wedding.

- Slow-cooked barbacoa with its traditional consomé.
- Hand-made quesadilla station (Oaxaca cheese, tinga, chorizo & potato, shredded beef, huitlacoche, mushrooms and more).
- Freshly squeezed orange juice and coffee.
- Garden and banquet area reset and cleaned before the brunch, waitstaff, taquero, dishwashing team and valet service (if required).
- 4 hours of service.

Approx. price: from USD \$35 per guest – minimum 50 guests.

Full Mexican Brunch Buffet

A more elaborate brunch experience that feels like a second mini-celebration.

- Mixed grill with meats, salads and sides.
- Live egg station (eggs cooked to order).
- Chilaquiles (red and/or green).
- Seasonal fruit, yogurt, granola and a selection of Mexican sweet bread.
- Fresh juice, soft drinks and coffee.
- Full service staff, set-up and clean-up, 4 hours of service.

Approx. price: from USD \$40 per guest – minimum 50 guests.

Final quotes may vary slightly depending on the exact guest count, timing and any customisations you choose.

8. Signature Experiences & Upgrades (in USD)

You can personalize your weekend with a curated menu of experiences. Prices below are approximate and can be adjusted to your final guest count and preferences.

Bar & Party Enhancements

Extra Shot Cart Round

Additional round of 50–60 shots served from our roaming shot cart; 2 rounds are already included in every weekend package. Approx. price: ~USD \$110 per round.

Beer & Wine Free-Flow (Friday)

Unlimited beer & wine in PRIVE for 3–4 hours (for Essential or Signature packages). Approx. price: from ~USD \$35 per guest.

Premium Open Bar (Friday)

Whisky, premium tequila, rum, beers and mixers for 4–5 hours in PRIVE (already included in the Grand Weekend; available as an upgrade for other packages). Approx. price: from ~USD \$60 per guest.

Food Stations & Social Tables

Cheese & Charcuterie Grazing Table

Large grazing table with cheeses, cured meats, breads and fruits for up to ~50 guests. Approx. price: ~USD \$1,200 total.

Late-Night Pizza Station

Fresh pizzas served as a late-night snack; perfect after the dance floor. Approx. price: ~USD \$16 per pizza (minimum 20 pizzas).

Snack & Fruit Bar

Colourful bar with fresh fruits, Mexican snacks, candies and crudités for around 50 guests. Approx. price: ~USD \$550 total.

Mezcal & Cultural Experiences

Mezcal Bar (for ~50 guests)

Bar with 2 wild agave mezcals, 2 signature mezcal cocktails, garnishes, full setup and service staff. Approx. price: ~USD \$1,600 total.

Private Mezcal Tasting (6 pax)

Intimate tasting for the couple and parents: cultural & sensorial experience with 3–4 mezcals, paired with a full meal (starter, main and dessert). Approx. price: ~USD \$480 total.

Mezcal Experience Combo

Mezcal bar for your guests plus the private 6-person tasting. Approx. price: ~USD \$1,950 total.

Photo & Video (by “Capturando Emociones”)

Photo and video services are offered by our partner studio “Capturando Emociones” and can be added to any weekend package.

Packages range approximately from:

- ~USD \$800–850 for “Esencia” (photo or video for 8 hours, album and enlargement).
- ~USD \$1,050–1,100 for “El Inicio de la Historia” (photo + video, 8 hours).
- ~USD \$1,600+ for “La Promesa Eterna” (photo + video + drone, 10 hours).
- ~USD \$2,150+ for “El Legado Nupcial” (dual camera teams, drone, 10 hours, album, wall art and long-term storage).

We’re happy to share the full photo/video catalog and help you choose the best option for your story.

9. How We Plan – Clear, Written and Structured

Our planning process always begins with a written exchange. Over the years, we’ve found that the most effective way to avoid miscommunication – especially with international couples – is to put everything in writing: the concept, the timeline, the logistics and all key decisions.

This written record becomes our shared reference, so at any point we can go back, review and confirm details together. A wedding involves hundreds of moving parts, both visible to guests and behind the scenes, so a simple, structured plan supported by checklists and clear milestones is essential to keep everything flowing smoothly.

We encourage couples to share, in as much detail as they wish, their dreams and expectations for the celebration – the atmosphere they envision, the emotions they want to inspire, and the personal touches that matter most. The more clearly we understand your priorities, the better we can align every decision with the experience you hope to create.

Visual flow of our process:

Message → Written Plan → Checklists → Execution → Review

10. Extending the Celebration – Day Trips & Nearby Experiences

Allegra is strategically located within about 45–90 minutes of extraordinary destinations, so it’s very easy to add optional day trips before or after the wedding day. Some popular options include:

- **Ancient ruins:** Xochicalco.
- **Mistical Caverns:** Cacahuamilpa.

- **Beautiful Lakes:** Tequesquitengo.
- **Rivers & natural springs:** Las Estacas.
- **Magic towns:** Tepoztlán.
- **World-renowned gardens:** Jardines de México.
- **Int'l Waterparks:** El Rollo / Six Flags.
- **Downtown Cuernavaca:** Palacio de Cortés, artisan market, Hacienda de Cortés.
- **Silver town:** Taxco.
- **Mexico City:** museums, historic centre and world-class dining (slightly further, ideal for pre- or post-stays).

11. The Great Mexican Escape – Wedding Week Experience

An all-in, weeklong life-story builder in Mexico for you, your family and friends.

For couples who want to transform their wedding into a week-long celebration, The Great Mexican Escape – Wedding Week Experience extends beyond the 3-day weekend and includes curated day trips and cultural activities, so your guests can enjoy Mexico to the fullest.

Our Great Mexican Escape – Wedding Week Experience is the weeklong version of our Grand Weekend: the same fully hosted wedding weekend, plus extra nights and curated day trips so your guests turn your wedding into a full Mexican escape.

Approx. USD \$595–695 per guest (depending on activities and lodging mix).

What's Included in The Great Mexican Escape

12. FAQ – Logistics, Payments & Extras

1. How do you handle airport pick-ups if our guests arrive at different times?

For international groups, we know that not everyone can land at the same time.

In the Signature and Grand weekend options, we include private vans with drivers for your group. Once your guests have booked their flights, we create a shared arrivals list (usually 4–6 weeks before the wedding) and group people into 2–3 main shuttle windows from the airport to Allegra, for example:

- one midday shuttle
- one late afternoon shuttle
- one evening shuttle (if needed)

Guests whose flights arrive within about 1–2 hours of each other are grouped on the same shuttle. This keeps everything organized and avoids too many separate trips.

If someone arrives outside those main windows, they have two options:

- wait comfortably at the airport for the next scheduled shuttle, or
- book a private transfer or Uber/taxi (we can recommend options).

We do the same on departure day, grouping guests into 2–3 shuttle windows back to the airport, according to their flight times.

2. How many people can sleep on-site at Allegra?

Between Allegra Homes (5 weekend houses, all within about a one-minute drive) and Allegra Suites (9 hotel-style rooms inside the venue), we can host around 61 guests inside the Allegra “bubble”.

Current approximate capacities are:

- Villa Las Fuentes – 10 guests
- Eucalipto 26 – 8 guests
- Fuentes 34A – 7 guests
- Villas Eucalipto – 10 guests
- Pedregal 20 – 8 guests
- Allegra Suites (inside the venue) – 18 guests

That adds up to about 61 guests sleeping within the Allegra private enclave, which is perfect for your closest family and friends. If you have more people, we can always suggest additional nearby accommodation for the remaining guests.

3. How do deposits and payments work?

To secure your date, we ask for an initial deposit of 20,000 MXN. Using a reference exchange rate of around 18.4 MXN per USD, that is approximately USD \$1,050–\$1,100 (around USD \$1,090), but your bank’s exact rate may vary slightly at the time of payment.

This initial deposit is:

- the same regardless of which weekend package (Essential, Signature or Grand) and upgrades you choose;
- used to block your date and begin planning.

The remaining balance is usually split into 2–3 additional payments (for example: one mid-way payment plus a final payment closer to the wedding date). We will outline a clear schedule that works for your planning timeline.

We currently offer three main payment options:

- Bank transfer in MXN to our local BBVA account in Mexico.
- USD transfers or Zelle to our Wells Fargo account in the United States.
- Credit card payment via a secure Stripe payment link.

Credit card processing fees for this service are not included in our package prices. In most cases, Stripe processing fees are around 4%, and they are simply added to the total when you choose to pay by card.

Because Jardín Allegra is one of the busiest wedding venues in Morelos and availability is very limited, we strongly encourage you to block your preferred date with the initial deposit as soon as you feel comfortable with the proposal and basic numbers.

4. What happens if the weather changes our plans?

We always design your weekend with a clear Plan A and Plan B.

Jardín Allegra 55 has covered areas and tent options, so your ceremony and reception can continue comfortably even with unexpected rain. We monitor the forecast closely in the days leading up to your wedding and coordinate with you to adjust timings, layouts or décor details if needed, so you never feel stressed about the weather.

5. Do you help us with vendors, or do we have to find everything ourselves?

You don't have to start from zero.

We work with a trusted network of photographers, florists, officiants, hair & make-up artists, cake designers and live musicians who already know the venue and how we operate. You are welcome to bring your own vendors as well (especially for photo & video), but most couples appreciate having a curated list and one central team coordinating everything on-site.

6. Can you accommodate special diets and food allergies?

Yes.

Our catering team is used to working with vegetarian, vegan, gluten-free and dairy-free guests, as well as specific allergies. Once your guest list is more defined, we'll ask you to share any special dietary needs so we can plan alternative plates and clearly labeled food stations.

The goal is that everyone feels included at the table, no matter their preferences.

7. Is language going to be a problem for our guests who don't speak Spanish?

Not at all.

Roberto and key team members speak fluent English, and many staff members understand basic English. All key signage, timelines and menus for your group can be prepared in English. If required, we could arrange a bilingual translator to be on-site the whole wedding.

Your guests will feel the warmth of Mexican hospitality with the comfort of clear communication throughout the weekend.

8. How far in advance should we book our date?

For international groups, we recommend booking at least 9–12 months in advance, especially if you're considering popular months or holiday weekends. Some dates are reserved even earlier.

If you're working with a shorter timeline, let us know your preferred dates and we'll check availability – sometimes we can still build something beautiful with less lead time.

9. What if some guests want to arrive earlier or stay longer?

That is actually very common.

Because we control Allegra Homes and Allegra Suites, we can often add extra nights before or after the main weekend, subject to availability. Guests who want to turn the wedding into a longer break in Mexico can extend their stay, and we can share ideas for day trips and activities in the region.

10. Is this only for symbolic weddings, or can we also do the legal ceremony?

Most international couples choose to handle the legal paperwork in their home country and celebrate a symbolic ceremony at Allegra. This gives more flexibility with timing, script and format.

However, if you are interested in exploring a full legal ceremony in Mexico, we can discuss the basic requirements and connect you with local professionals who can guide you through the process.

11. What is your cancellation or rescheduling policy?

Life happens, and we understand that plans sometimes need to change.

Our standard policy is that the initial deposit is non-refundable, because it blocks your date and turns away other events. However, in many cases we can explore rescheduling to another available weekend within a defined timeframe, applying part of the amounts already paid.

All specific terms will be clearly explained in your formal proposal and contract, so you know exactly where you stand before committing.

12. Are children welcome?

Yes.

Families are welcome, and many couples bring younger siblings, nieces and nephews. We can help you design a kid-friendly plan (for example, early dinner, quiet rooms for naps, babysitter contacts) so parents can relax and enjoy the celebration.

If you prefer an adults-focused weekend, we can also share examples of how other couples have communicated “adults only” or “limited children” in a warm and respectful way.

13. Final Differentiator – Why Allegra Feels Different & Next Steps

At Allegra, it's not just a wedding day. It's a life trip – three days of togetherness, culture and celebration that turn into memories for a lifetime.

Instead of scattering your guests across different hotels and venues, you host them in one private enclave – wedding venue, villas & suites – in Cuernavaca:

- Everyone arrives together, relaxes by the pools and starts reconnecting from day one.
- You swap the traditional rehearsal dinner for a Taco Party & Karaoke Night at PRIVE, where ice is broken in the most Mexican way possible.
- On Saturday, you walk from your house to your ceremony and reception at Jardín Allegra 55 – no buses, no long transfers, just a few steps between “home” and “I do”.
- On Sunday, you say goodbye slowly over a Recovery Brunch, sharing stories, photos and tears of joy before everyone flies back home.

That shared time in one shared place – sleeping, celebrating and recovering within the Allegra bubble – is what makes this feel so different from a standard hotel or resort wedding.

For many couples, it becomes not only their wedding, but the **core memory of their life abroad**: a long weekend where both worlds meet – family, friends and cultures – and everything finally comes together.

Ready to Start Planning Your International Wedding Weekend?

If this vision resonates with you, the next step is simple and fully done in writing (email or messaging) so everything stays clear and easy to review:

1. Tell us your preferred month and year, and whether you imagine a 3-day weekend or a full wedding week.

2. Share your approximate guest count (for example: 50–60 guests, 80–100 guests, etc.).

3. Let us know if there is anything that matters especially to you – for example, more time for family, a very strong party atmosphere, or a focus on food, culture and local experiences.

With that information, we will:

- confirm tentative availability for your dates,
- suggest the weekend package (Essential, Signature or Grand) and, if relevant, a Great Mexican Escape – Wedding Week version, and
- send you a written first sketch of your wedding weekend at Allegra, including an estimated per-guest range in USD and suggested add-ons.
